Information for Parents/Guardians

- You can apply for a 30 hours funding eligibility code up to 16 weeks before your child's 3rd birthday.
- You must ensure that you apply for your code before the following deadline dates:
 - o 31st December to claim funding in the Spring term
 - o 31st March to claim funding in the Summer term
 - o 31st August to claim funding in the Autumn term
- To apply for a code and to renew your code please visit <u>https://www.gov.uk/sign-in-childcare-account</u>
- You must renew your code every 3 months to ensure it remains valid.
- HMRC will send a reminder via email or text when you need to renew your code.
- Once you receive you eligibility code you must ensure that you give your code to your childcare provider to receive the funding.
- Each 30 hour code comes with a grace period. This allows for the funding to continue for a limited period of time, if you cease to meet the eligibility criteria, i.e., if you loose your job.
- If you only want to use a maximum of 15 hours funding per week then you don't need to apply for a 30 hours funding code.
- Tax free childcare is a different scheme to the 30 hours funding but it can be used alongside the 30 hours funding. You have to apply and renew them separately.

- Permanent eligibility codes start with 500 however, temporary codes start with 11 and codes for foster children start with 400.
- To apply for an eligibility code for a foster child, the social worker and foster parents must apply by contacting FIS on 01452 427362.
- You can split your 30 hours funding between a maximum of 2 providers per day.
- You don't have to use the full 30 hours of funding.
